- These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, Short title and commencement.- (1) Scientific Officer, Group 'B' Gazetted Posts, Directorate of Forensic Science Services, Junior Recruitment Rules, 2023.
 - They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette. (2)
- Number of post, classification and level in the pay matrix. The number of post, its classification 2. and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.- The method of recruitment, age-limit, 3. qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.
- Disqualification. No person, -4.
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 5. Power to relax. - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category or persons.
- Saving. Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions 6. required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, ex-servicemen and Other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Master degree in forensic Science with Physics or chemistry or electronics or Multimedia as one of the subjects during all the three years of Bachelor of Science from recognized university or Institute with at least one year diploma in photography from recognized university or institute.

(A) Essential experience: Three years' experience of

analytical methods and research therein in the relevant field from a government recognized organization or institution.

(B) Desirable: - One-year experience of working in a Forensic Science Laboratory under the Central or State Government or Union territory administration after obtaining the minimum educational qualifications as specified under col. (7).

Note 1: The relevant discipline in educational qualification and areas in which research experience is required shall be the division for which the recruitment is being made.

Note 2: Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission, for reasons to be recorded in writing, in case of candidates otherwise well qualified.

Note 3: The qualification regarding experience is relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission, for the reasons to be recorded in writing, in case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes, if at any stage of selection, the Union Public Service Commission is of the opinion of that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisites experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.

Note: The eligibility service for promotion to the post of Junior Scientific Officer shall continue to be three years for persons holding the feeder posts of Senior Scientific Assistant on regular basis on the date of notification of the earlier RRs of Junior Scientific Officer vide GSR 125 dated 25.10.2021.
