G.S.RIn exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Directorate of Forensic Science Services, Services, Services, Central Forensic Science Laboratory, Central Bureau of Investigation, Senior Scientific Assist Poroup 'B' Non-Gazetted Post Recruitment Rules, 2022 in so far as they relate to the post of Scientific Assistant except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, President hereby makes the following rules to regulate the method of recruitment to the post of Scientific Assistant, in the Ministry of Home Affairs, Directorate of Forensic Science Services and putlying units, namely:-	nior ome tant, nior the

- 1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, Directorate of Forensic Science Services, Senior Scientific Assistant, Group 'B' Non- Gazetted Post Recruitment Rules, 2023.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix.— The number of posts, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.- The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.
- 4. Disqualification.- No person, -
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category or persons.

6. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard. time to time in this regard.

- (g) Senior Scientific Assistant (Documents): Master degree in Physics or Chemistry from a recognised University or Institute; or Master degree in Forensic Science with Chemistry or Physics as one of the subjects during all the three years of Bachelor of Science from a recognised University or Institute.
- (h) Senior Scientific Assistant (Document Photographer): Master degree in Physics or Chemistry or Electronics with at least one-year Diploma in Photography from a recognised University or Institute; or

Master degree in Forensic Science with Physics or Chemistry or

Electronics or Multimedia as one of the subjects during all the 3 years of Bachelor of Science from recognized University or Institute with at least one-year Diploma in Photography from recognised University or Institute. Note 2.- Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organization/ department of the Central/State Government shall ordinarily not to exceed 4 years.
